


After I found them I then stood in the kitchen and followed your directions with a compass and the 15 degrees south was pointing right at them!

Let's take a quick look at the horary chart

The keys are ruled by the second house. The house of possessions. So we turn to Mercury for the ruler of the keys. We find Mercury intercepted in the 11th house. The interception means that it will be harder to find. They are not in plain sight. We find the Moon void of course in the first house. My experience with the Moon void of course regarding lost articles, especially if it's in an angle, is that you will find the lost item. I also use the local space for compass direction. Mercury is in a fire sign so look on the East wall. There are lot more techniques to use in my book. I use five significators to help me describe the location and timing and more to find the lost items. The book describes possible locations in the house and outside the house. Every astrologer should have this book on their bookshelf.
